

2010 Amgen Tour of California Stage 6 Finish in Big Bear Lake on Friday, May 21, 2010

1. Arrive Early: It is recommended to **arrive before 10 a.m.** on race day to secure seating near the Snow Summit finish line. See the reverse map for nearby limited Early Bird parking at \$10 per vehicle, many other free parking options, and walking paths and bike routes to the finish area. There are **places to park vehicles** along the roadside on or near the course, including Stanfield Cutoff, and North Shore Drive (Hwy. 38), and side roads on Hwy. 38 such as North Shore Lane, Polique Canyon Road and Holcomb Valley Road. Spectators may park on these roads as long as **all four tires are off the roadway**. Please be considerate of private and U.S. Forest Service property. Also, there are U.S. Forest Service parking areas along Hwy. 38 including Grout Bay Park, Grays Peak Trail head, Cougar Crest Trailhead, Juniper Point and The Woodland Trail. U.S. Forest Service parking areas do require vehicles to display a National Forest Adventure Pass, which can be purchased at Big Bear Discovery Center for \$5. Note that there are **several routes to get to Big Bear:** for spectators coming from L.A., Orange County, San Diego or the Inland Empire, Hwy. 38 is recommended, which you can easily be accessed from the Orange Street exit off I-10 in Redlands. For spectators coming from Northern L.A. County or desert communities, use Hwy. 18 through Lucerne Valley. Spectators who plan to come up Hwy. 330 to stake out a spot along Hwy. 18 in areas such as Rim of the World Highway or the Arctic Circle are encouraged to arrive before 11 a.m.

2. Bring Your Bike: On race day it is easier to get around Big Bear on a bike rather than a car. See the map on the reverse for easy-access bike routes to the finish line area. Free parking in the Big Bear Village is a great choice for spectators to **park vehicles, and then ride to the finish line**, or other viewing area along the route. Spectators may check bikes at the free bike valet at the Snow Summit finish, and enjoy the Lifestyle Festival and other race day festivities. The **free bike valet** operates from 10:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. Bike valet spaces are limited. After the race the Park 'n' Bike option allows spectators to **beat the traffic** out of the finish line area by riding back to the Village on a bike. At the Village secure the bike on a vehicle or chain it up, and enjoy the lively festivities of Friday Night in the Village!

3. Stay & Enjoy: A variety of related events provide plenty of entertainment and activities both **before and after** the arrival of the cyclists: At the Snow Summit finish there is the interactive **MBT Lifestyle Festival**, live entertainment, a beer garden, food concessions, Big Bear Health & Fitness Expo, cycling demonstrations, bike safety, national sponsors, vendors, cycling gear, local artists, family activities, and more. There are also **giant screen TVs** to follow the riders live from Wrightwood as they race to the finish. After the awards ceremony, enjoy alpine dining and shopping during **Friday Night in the Village**. On Saturday, enjoy a scenic bike tour at the inaugural **Tour de Big Bear** (www.tourdebigbear.com). Note that overnight guests staying in Big Bear benefit in several ways: They save the hassle of driving up and down the mountain and **avoid race day traffic**. And not only can they get the best seats near the finish line, but they also have the best chance to spot cycling pros spending Friday night in Big Bear, which has a wide range of lodging **accommodations that fits every taste and budget**. Big Bear Locals: If you must travel on Friday, May 21, consider alternate routes and avoid the main roads as much as possible. Be advised routes between the East and West sides of the Big Bear Valley will be congested due to traffic and closures from approximately 2 p.m. to 5 p.m. Please plan accordingly.
